## XPU Preposition Standards

1. Assigned resources will report directly to the Task Force Leader or assigned Chief Officer.
2. The Task Force Leader or Chief Officer will coordinate with local Chief's as needed for special considerations such as training needs, local concerns, projects, etc.
3. All personnel must be Qualified to CICC standards and carry Qualification Cards (Red Card).
4. Follow the Chain of Command, ICS Standards and the 10's and 18's.
5. Report any Safety issues immediately and understand they will be reported to the OAC(s), OES and the Chief's Association and taken seriously. Be sure to use the term "Safety" appropriately, misuse or abuse of the term will be investigated equally.
6. **Personnel must stay together with their assigned apparatus for the entire Preposition.**
7. Resources will respond within 1 minute during daytime hours with all assigned personnel.
8. All personnel must stay with the assigned apparatus at night with a maximum of a 3 minute response.
9. Assigned resources will monitor local radio frequencies for the entire assignment.
10. Assigned resources will serve the County at the direction of Task Force Leader or Chief Officer, regardless of Mutual Aid or Automatic Aid Agreements.
11. Resources will be able to support themselves for 24 hours.
12. Do not apply for or take a Preposition Assignment if you can't cover your district, you may be requested to respond elsewhere.
13. Maintain and save an ICS 214 (Unit Log) for all resources while on Preposition.
14. All disputes and grievances unable to be resolved by the Leader will be directed to the Chief's Association President for further action. There will be no direct contact with OES.
